STREIF Baulogistik expands rental equipment by 54 revolving tower cranes and 871 containers

Streif Baulogistik has increased its range of rental equipment. At the 2010 bauma trade fair, the company signed several contracts with appropriate manufacturers to add a further 48 Liebherr top slewing cranes (30 to 250mt) along with six Wolff cranes (120 to 280mt) to its fleet of revolving tower cranes. The company also purchased 871 containers made by ALHO Systembau. Thorsten Wiesendorfer, Managing Director of Streif Baulogistik: "We have purchased these new products in line with our equipment strategy, to modernize and increase our rental base. As the market is picking up, this is the right time to make these investments."

Liebherr and Streif Baulogistik have cooperated as partners in the revolving tower crane sector for many years. At the bauma, their existing supply agreement first signed in 1999 was extended to include the entire Streif Baulogistik group. Streif's rental equipment now includes 600 cranes of varying types. In the container sector, the company now owns over 8,000 modules of different models. The lion's share of the new units purchased has already been allocated to specific projects. "We are currently getting an increasing number of inquiries particularly from contracting authorities. Our containers are used here as transitional facilities during school and kindergarden renovations," says Thorsten Grabowski, head of Central Procurement/Fleet Management at Streif Baulogistik, in explanation of the company's investment. ALHO Systembau and Streif Baulogistik have been partners in the mobile container systems sector for many years.
